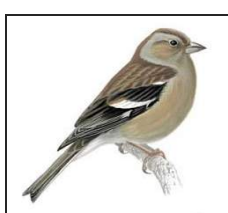
Male: Yellow and Green

Female: Olive-brown upperparts, grey crown

Food: Seeds, worms and bread

Male: Grey body, pink

Female: Same as the male

Food: Worms, seeds and oats

Male: Brown body with red chest

Female: Same as the male

Food: Sweet food like cake and bread crumbs

Male: Brown body with grey chest and white cheeks

Female: Same as the male
